Safety information for all participants

1. It is a condition of entry that the SHCT, save to the extent required by law, accepts no responsibility in respect of death, injury or damage caused by or to any participant during the sponsored event. All entrants under 16 must have their parents' consent.
2. Police advise all cyclists to ride in single file. If any group contains more than six riders, please leave a suitable gap between the groups of six in order not to inconvenience motorists. Please study the bicycling section of the Highway Code, and make sure your machine is roadworthy before setting out. Brakes and tyres are particularly important. If possible, wear bright clothing with a fluorescent band and safety helmets.
3. When you leave your bicycle, for whatever reason, please lock it.
4. Any Horse riders must have their own personal Insurance.
